ONLINE ELOCUTION IN ENGLISH

The first Elocution contest in English for each Section of the College (Preparatory/ Junior/ Middle/ Senior) shall be held sometime in August, 2020. This shall be online in the manner delineated below.

- 1. Pupils of each Class and section who wish to participate must send a video clipping of an elocution piece fulfilling the criteria given below.*
- 2. Contestants are to be dressed in College summer uniform.
- 3. Contestants must send a printed copy of the piece being recited by email, as an attachment.
- 4. Nos 1 & 3 above are to sent to the specific email address of the class, lamartiniereclass_@gmail.com stating in the main message the following:
 - a. Name
 - b. Class
 - c. Section
 - d. Title of the Composition
- 5. The video clippings shall be rated by the teachers concerned and the selection of a single speaker to represent each section shall be made, in consultation with the Head of the Section.
- 6. The last date for submission of entries is 31 July, 2020.
- 7. The Final Contest shall be held via a live Zoom Meeting, for which the date shall be announced later.
- 8. Independent judges shall mark the live presentation, which can be watched by viewers in any location.
- 9. Winners shall be announced through social media.
- 10. The presentations of the winners shall be uploaded on social media.
- 11. Prizes shall be awarded in the usual manner.

*Criteria

1. Each Section of each Class shall be represented in the final contest by a single speaker who shall a recite a poem/extract on a common theme. There is no restriction on the number of contestants who may recite the same poem at the short-listing stage. Only ONE representative per Class/Section shall be selected. The Themes allotted are as follows:

- 2. A copy of the extract chosen must be sent via email to the Class specific email address as an attachment.
- 3. Each extract shall be for a maximum of 2 minutes (120 seconds)
- 4. Short-listing shall take into account the contestant's ability to memorise the selected piece.
- 5. Marks shall be awarded for short-listing and the final contest keeping in mind the following:
 - a. Relevance of selection of poem/extract to theme
 - b. Memory
 - c. Expression
 - d. Modulation
 - e. Pronunciation
