

## **ONLINE ELOCUTION IN ENGLISH -2021**

- 2. The last date for submission of Registration entries is **16<sup>th</sup> June**, **2021**.
- 3. Each pupil who has registered himself shall then be sent an elocution piece by the teachers concerned, which he shall memorise and make a video clipping of the same.
- 4. The video clippings are to be sent to the specific email address of the class,\* with their name, class, section and personal number mentioned

- 5. Contestants are to be dressed in College summer uniform.
- 6. The last date for submission of video clipping is **21st June**, **2021**.
- 7. The video clippings shall be rated by the teachers concerned and the selection of a single speaker to represent each section shall be made, in consultation with the Head of the Section. Each Section of each Class shall be represented in the final contest by a single speaker.
- 8. The selected candidates shall then be informed officially.
- 9. The boys selected shall be trained by the teacher via WhatsApp Video call on the WhatsApp number used in your registration.
- 10. The Final Contest shall be held via a live Zoom Meeting, for which the link shall be announced later.
- 11. Independent judges shall mark the live presentation, which can be watched by viewers in any location.
- 12. Winners shall be announced through social media.
- 13. The presentations of the winners shall be uploaded on social media.
- 14. Prizes shall be awarded in the usual manner.
