This is the Report on the 178<sup>th</sup> academic session of La Martiniere College, Lucknow.

The Academic Session began on 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 and concluded on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024.

The session marked an important significance as during this session the outgoing Principal, Mr Carlyle Andre McFarland completed his tenure of service of twelve years and retired on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024, while Mr Gary Dominic Everett took charge as the Principal of the College from 01<sup>st</sup> April, 2024. Mr Everett, before joining as the Principal, was the Principal of the Laidlaw Memorial School & Jr College, Ketti, Nilgiris (TN), having 29 years of vast experience in the field of education and added several accolades to his name. The College warmly welcomed him on his appointment.

## **ENROLMENT**

As on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 there were 3257 pupils on roll of the College. This includes, 366 boys in the Preparatory Department. The Day-Scholar strength was marked at 2307. ## **SCHOOL LEAVING EXAMINATIONS**

### **Indian School Certificate (ISC) Year 12**

In the summer of 2023, 282 candidates were appeared for the ISC (Year 12) Examination conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations. Out of 282 candidates, 281 were awarded Pass Certificates.

### **Orientation for Parents of Nursery Pupils**

The Orientation Programme for parents at the pre-primary level held on 14<sup>th</sup> of April, 2023 marked the beginning of a collaborative journey between parents, teachers, and the school to nurture the holistic development of our youngest learners. The In Charge and Staff of the Pre Primary Department was introduced and the history and traditions of the College was explained. Representatives of Innate Pro were present to explain the significance of the Dermatoglyphics Test that all boys undertook to determine learning styles and dominant intelligences.

The orientation programme received positive feedback from parents, who appreciated the opportunity to learn more about the pre-primary programme and interact with teachers and school staff. Many parents expressed confidence and satisfaction in the school's approach to early childhood education and voiced their commitment to supporting their child's learning journey.

The Evening Bazaar scheduled to be held on 06<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 was cancelled due to sudden demise of one of the colleague, Mr Nigel Hopley, who served the College as a Librarian. The events scheduled till the commencement of the summer vacation were cancelled.

The draw for the Raffle for the conservation of Constantia was held at the daily Assembly on 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2023. A net amount of Rs 5,41,900/- was contributed towards the restoration of Constantia from this.

### **Spelling Bee Competitions**

To encourage accuracy in language, the final competitions of Spelling Bee for the Middle School were held from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2023; for the Junior School on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 and for the Preparatory Department on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2024. This included representation from every section of the class. In the Middle School, Aarav Bahadur Mathpal won the competition in Class 6, while Shivaan Rastogi and Anant Singh were the winners in Classes 7 and 8, respectively. 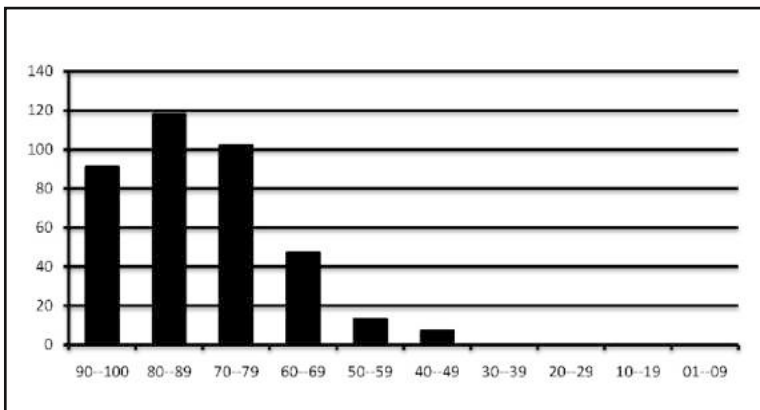

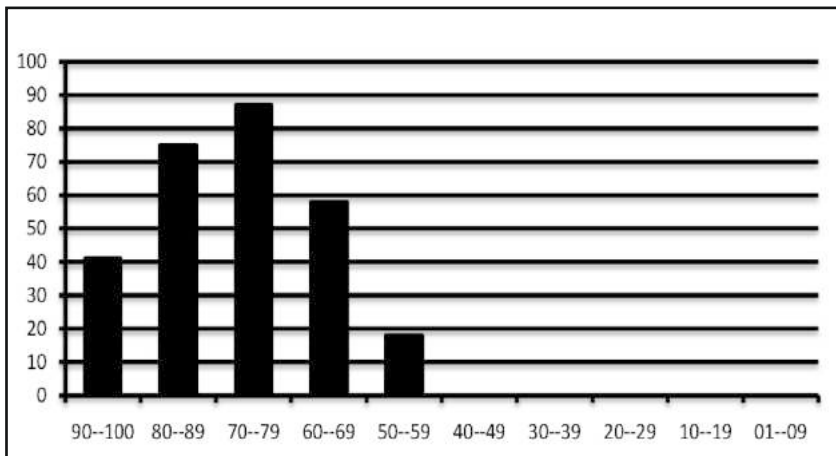
