



ALL PARENTS OF RESIDENT SCHOLARS OF CLASSES 10 to 12

The Government has issued a G.O. No 305/15-7-2021-1(20)/2020T.C. dated 05 February 2021 for resumption of Boarding Schools. This is in addition to optional physical classes for Day Scholars already notified.

The Boarding house shall resume with the following conditions and instructions:

1. The Boarding House facilities shall resume **ONLY** for Resident Scholars of Classes 10 and 12 w.e.f. **25 February 2021**.
2. Boarding facilities shall be offered to pupils as per the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Resident Scholars published by the Government. The on-line/distance education model shall continue for pupils choosing not to return as of now.
3. Resident Scholars are required to bring with them a current / valid **COVID-19 negative medical report** from the competent authority before returning to the Boarding house.
4. While travelling in public transport / trains the pupils must avoid interaction with fellow passengers and must maintain social distancing as advised to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
5. No person other than authorised staff of the Boarding house shall be allowed entry in the residential areas in use by the Resident Scholars. Parents/ Guardian shall not be allowed beyond the office of the Dormitory Superintendent.
6. The visiting medical team of the Government may inspect the Kitchen and Dining areas once a week.
7. Pupils of the above mentioned classes shall only be permitted to return to the Boarding House after a **NO OBJECTION/PERMISSION** is provided by the parents of the pupil in the format attached herewith. This must be sent by email to principal@lamartiniereLucknow.org by **22 February 2021**.
8. For ease in recording and identification, a printout of the email is to be carried by the pupil and handed over to the Dormitory Superintendent upon arrival.

NO PUPIL SHALL BE PERMITTED TO JOIN THE BOARDING HOUSE WITHOUT WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE PARENTS. A PRINTOUT OF THE EMAIL FOR WRITTEN CONSENT IS TO BE CARRIED BY THE PUPIL.

9. To avoid additional expenditure to parents at this time, pupils shall wear College winter OR summer uniform. Haircuts as per the College norm are to be ensured.
10. There shall be **NO TUCK SHOP** facilities until further orders.
11. There shall be no use of **ANY** playing field until further orders.
12. In the interest of health safety, it is **compulsory** for pupils to:
 - 1 Wear prescribed face cover / masks at all times. These are to be of self-colour, without printing and designs.

- ii Carry a limited amount (100 ml.) of alcohol based hand-sanitizer for individual use.
 - iii It is advised that pupils carry:
 - iv Water-bottles for individual use.
 - v Rubber gloves for added protection.
13. The use of mobile telephones and digital devices, such as laptops, etc. is temporarily permitted by the College. This must be with the permission of parents, as given in the NO OBJECTION/PERMISSION by them. The College shall not take any responsibility for any damage, loss or allegations of theft of any mobile/digital device.

For the reassurance of parents, the following needs to be kept in mind:

1. The Dormitory, House Rooms, Dining Hall and all other facilities shall be re-sanitised on 25th February 2021 prior to the reopening of the facilities and thereafter done on a regular basis.
2. In the eventuality of any Resident Scholar developing any symptoms of COVID-19 he shall be isolated in the isolation ward of the College infirmary and the parents shall be informed accordingly. In accordance with Government guidelines the concerned health officials shall also be informed.
3. Resident Scholars and domestic staff shall **wear face cover** at all time and carry their own personal hand sanitizer.
4. No outside vendor like Amazon / Flipcart / Swiggy etc shall be allowed entry in the campus.
5. Sufficient distance has been provided between the beds in the dormitories.
6. There shall be no organised games or permission to use the play fields until further orders.
7. Sanitizers shall be available in the public areas in addition to the personal sanitizers compulsorily carried by each pupil. Hand-wash shall be available in the lavatories.
8. Furniture in classrooms / Study rooms has been arranged to ensure a minimum of SIX feet distance in the seating of each pupil.
9. All pupils shall be sensitized about the spread of Covid-19 and the measures to prevent it.

It is reiterated that the present steps are being taken to gradually resume all physical activities of the Boarding House. The health of our pupils is paramount. All reasonable precautions, as given above, shall be enforced. The cooperation of parents is required, along with the counselling of pupils, to minimize risks to themselves and others. The implementation of these measures shall be reviewed daily and a flexible approach shall be adopted for the reassurance of parents.

Kindly note that further instructions shall be communicated when received from the Government.

- 1- COVID-19 is a pandemic which is spread primarily by social contacts. This pandemic has affected several lakhs of people. In keeping with Government health and safety guidelines social distancing is to be maintained for the resumption of important duties. I have given my son all instructions in this regard.
- 2- The College is taking all precautions in keeping with Government guidelines and instructions to prevent the spread of COVID-19. However the College does not guarantee that in the future no pupil or their parents will not be affected by the pandemic.

After careful consideration and following counselling of my son regarding safety measures required during the pandemic, I hereby consent to my son physically attending lessons as delineated above. I grant permission for him to physically attend lessons on the designated days and have no objection to his attendance. I am conscious of the risks involved due to the ongoing pandemic. I understand that the College shall fulfil the commitments made for the health safety of my son. I understand that this is a cooperative effort to which my son shall contribute.
